On Wednesday, July 13, the Ozarka College Board of Trustees held a special board meeting for the appointment of an interim President and Vice President of Academic Affairs.


After discussion regarding possible candidates, the board unanimously voted to appoint current Vice President of Finance, Gayle Cooper to fill the position of interim President and former board member, Dr. Gary Phillips of Salem, was appointed as interim Vice President of Academic Affairs. Both appointments were filled on a temporary, three to six month time period, to

allow the board and college administrators to begin a search for candidates to permanently fill the two positions.

Early Orientation/Registration Held July 7

August ASSET Testing Dates Announced

The Asset Placement Test is made up of four different sections which measure student comprehension in writing skills, reading skills, numerical skills, and intermediate algebra. Potential students who plan to enroll during the Fall 2005 term must take the ACT or the ASSET Placement Test. ASSET test scores are required for placement in English, reading, and mathematics.

There is a \$10 fee for the Asset test which can be paid in the Business Office of the Melbourne Campus or the Administration Offices at the Ash Flat and Mountain View locations. The Ash Flat and Mountain View offices will give instructions at the time of payment. If the exam is being taken on the Melbourne Campus please congregate in the dining room in the Main building. It is advised to arrive at least 15 minutes before the scheduled test time. Acceptable identification must be presented at the time of testing or admission to the test will be denied. Acceptable forms of identification may include current official photo ID such as a driver's license.
